CLUBHOUSE RULES

1. The Clubhouse is available for use by Members and their guests only.
2. Members must identify the names of their guests in the Court Reservation System and are responsible for payment for everything supplied to and obtained by guests, and no guest is allowed to tender payment thereof.
3. No notices may be placed on the Clubhouse notice board except by an Officer, Director, or manager of the Club.
4. Members are jointly and severally responsible for maintaining the appearance of the Clubhouse as regards both sanitary and general tidiness.
5. The Clubhouse is open for the use of Members every day including Public Holidays. It will be opened by the Club Manager or his nominee from 7:00am until 11:00am and from 3:00pm until 7:00pm. The last player to leave the Clubhouse shall lock the Bar and turn off all lights.
6. Care must be taken by all members to avoid a fire hazard. Smoking is not permitted on the property including the tennis courts, walkways, verandas, bleachers or in the Clubhouse.
7. Noise in and around the Clubhouse is to be kept at a minimum when the courts are in use.
8. Infringements of noise levels should be reported to a Director who will take whatever action is required against the Member concerned and duly report the incident at the next meeting of Directors. Repeated infringements of excessive noise will result in the offending member suffering disallowance of Club privileges for such period as determined and advised by the Directors.
9. Dogs are not allowed on the Club's property.

COURT USE

- 2.1 Courts may be reserved by Members (using their unique login details for the booking system) on any day of the week except "Club Days". The Member(s) reserving the court(s) must use the online/electronic booking system (available at

- the Clubhouse) to ensure proper billing of the court; only the member(s) noted in the booking will be billed for the court(s). If rain washes out play entirely, the reservation will not be billed (The Club Manager to oversee).
- 2.2 During periods when tournaments or other club functions are in operation no reservations of courts may be made unless permitted by the Tournament Director or his nominee.
- 2.3 Unless otherwise provided by the Directors, “Club Days” are as follows:
- Sunday mornings from 7:00am until noon, and Friday evenings from 5:30pm to 10:00 pm.
- (a) Members will play, on arrival at the courts and in turn with other Members waiting to play – doubles only. When there are insufficient numbers, Student Players or guests of Full Members may participate by invitation only.
 - (b) No Student Player or Guest may participate or continue to participate in any session when sixteen or more Members are present.
 - (c) In all cases where less than four Members have to retire from the court to give place to other Members waiting to play, it shall be settled by “toss” or by mutual consent who shall retire.
 - (d) Throughout the duration of “Club Days” Members are encouraged to change partners after each set.
 - (e) The charge for the use of the court for “Club Days” per person is as according to the current fee addendum and includes the use of balls (to be organized by the Club Manager).
- 2.4 Courts shall not be used unless recorded in the online booking reservation system prior to use.

ENTRANCE FEES

- 3.1 The entrance fee for all Full Membership Categories (Local, Overseas & Social) must accompany the Application Form and shall be as according to the current Fee Addendum. All Full members are eligible to vote.

- 3.2 There shall be no entrance fee for Corporate Members. Corporate members do not have voting rights.
- 3.3 There shall be no entrance fee for Temporary Members. Temporary members do not have voting rights.

SUBSCRIPTIONS

- 4.1 Annual Subscriptions for all Full Membership categories (Local, Overseas & Social) shall be as according to the current Fee Addendum. Court fees are also payable by Full members – See 5.1(a) below.
- 4.2 Subscriptions for Temporary Members shall be as according to the current Fee Addendum. Court fees are also payable by Temporary Members – See 5.1(b) below.
- 4.3 Subscriptions for Corporate members shall be as according to the current Fee Addendum. Court fees are also payable by Corporate Members – See 5.1(c) below.
- 4.4 All subscriptions are payable in advance.
- 4.5 If any Member shall fail to pay his subscription within (90) days, he shall cease to be a member, but the Directors may have the discretion to waive this Bye-Law in exceptional circumstance.

COURT FEES

- 5.1 Fees for court use per session (except for organized events) shall be as in according with the current Fee Addendum.

5.2 All members account and court fee are payable monthly in arrears or at such times as the Directors may from time to time require.

STUDENT PLAYERS

- 6.1 Student Players are not Members of the Club. They are accorded playing privileges by the Members and have no rights as to the running of the Club, but nonetheless, it is the desire of the Club that Student Players be encouraged to play tennis and be given the opportunity to play as much as possible in the hope that they may better appreciate the game of tennis and become Members in the course of time.
- 6.2 Students (enrolled in fulltime education and supported by their parents up to the age of twenty four) are eligible for acceptance as Student Members on application being made to the Membership Secretary of the Club by one parent or guardian, on the prescribed form and proposed and seconded by two Full Members.
- 6.3 Student Players may, on acceptance, enjoy the facilities of the Club without payment of an Entrance Fee and will be eligible to become Full Members of the Club at any age over eighteen (or at age 24) or if they cease to meet the qualifications of a Student Player (see 6.2) without being liable for an Entrance Fee, PROVIDED THAT such person shall have been a Student Player for not less than twenty-four (24) months.
- 6.4 The Directors have the right to change the classification of any Student Player to Member, effective the twenty fourth birthday of the Student Player or when the Student Player does not meet the requirements of this classification (see 6.2)
- 6.5 Subscriptions for Student Players shall be as according to the current Fee Addendum.

- 6.6 The parent or guardian signing the application form is responsible for all subscriptions and other charges incurred by the Student Player, his or her safety and behavior on the club's premises.
- 6.7 The parent or guardian signing the application form is responsible for notifying the Membership Secretary of the Club when a Student Player wishes to resign; otherwise, such parent or guardian shall be liable to pay all future subscriptions.
- 6.8 The subscriptions paid by the parent or guardian for a Student Player does not entitle the parent or guardian to the use of the Club's sporting facilities, but parents and guardians are encouraged to visit the Club at any time.
- 6.9 Subscriptions do not cover any charges incurred for formal lessons received by Student Players, or any entry fee for any organized Club event that the Student Player may be eligible.
- 6.10 Student Players whose subscriptions are paid up to date are permitted to use the club courts at no charge during "off peak" times, provided that the court had not been reserved. The Student Player must leave the court when no other court is available and is requested to do so by a Full Member. During "peak" times (5:30pm – 10:00pm) Student Players are subject to the same charges as Full Members and therefore should not be asked to leave the court by a Full Member.
- 6.11 Student Players are required to use the online/electronic booking system available in the Clubhouse.
- 6-12 Student Players are not permitted to play in "Club Days" unless by special invitation of a Full Member.
- 6.13 At all times Student Players using the courts and grounds must be careful to behave properly and not make unnecessary noise on or off the courts which may be distracting to other players.
- 6.14 Student Players are not allowed to bring guests unless prior permission is obtained from the Club Manager, Officer or any Director, and the same guest is not permitted to visit more that once in any calendar month.
- 6.15 Student Players are eligible to participate in tournaments organized by the Club for Members by invitation of the Club Manager, Officer or any Director only.
- 6.16 Should any Student Player willfully refuse or neglect to comply with the provisions of these Bye-Laws or be guilty of any conduct unworthy of a young

lady or gentleman or likely to be injurious to the Club, such Student Player shall be liable to expulsion at the discretion of the Directors.

DRESS CODE

- 7.1 Proper tennis attire, including shirts, shall be worn at all times on the courts and around the grounds. No gym wear allowed.
- 7.2 Only smooth-soled shoes are to be worn on the courts. This provision applies to all players including Full Members, Temporary Members, Corporate Members, Student Players and guests. Shoes must not have marking soles.
